2 Corinthians 1 is the first chapter of the Second Epistle to the Corinthians in the New Testament of the Christian Bible. It is authored by Paul the Apostle and Timothy (2 Corinthians 1:1) in Macedonia in 55â€“56 CE. The original text was written in Koine Greek. This chapter is divided into 24 verses. Some early manuscripts containing the text of this chapter are: Papyrus 46 (~AD 200). Codex Vaticanus (325â€“350). Codex Sinaiticus (330â€“360). Codex Alexandrinus (400â€“440; complete).
