White (1995) defines free banking as " a monetary system without a central bank, under which the issuing of currency and deposit money is left to legally unrestricted private banks, " a definition representative of a general consensus in the free banking literature -see, for example, Dowd (1993). White points out that, as a monetary regime, free banking is not a new idea. For example, Browne and Cronin (1996) pointed out that laissez-faire banking could emerge endogenously over time in response to technological improvements in information and financial products.
