The trial began on 3 December. On 4 December the Convention's president Bertrand Barbré presented it with the fatal indictment (drafted by Jean-Baptiste Robert Lindet) and decreed the interrogation of Louis XVI. Louis made his entrance into the Convention chamber then: "Louis", said Barbré de Vieuzac, "the nation accuses you King Louis XVI was put on trial by the National Convention and executed Jan 21, 1793.
