It provides both a mechanism for articulating local approaches to environmental issues, and a regulatory regime through which measures to address environmental concerns may be pursued. The planning system has traditionally been concerned with issues of environmental protection and quality. In the 1980s, the multiplier between land values for agricultural and urban uses was found to run at 50-200 (times) or even higher in the areas surrounding expanding cities in Japan and Britain, compared to 2-3 in the Netherlands (no servicing costs considered).
