"Tractatus Logico-Philosophicus" is the only book-length work published by Austrian philosopher Ludwig Wittgenstein. He wrote it as a soldier and a prisoner of war during World War I. First published in German in 1921 as "Logisch-Philosophische Abhandlung", it is now widely considered one of the most important philosophical works of the twentieth century. "Tractatus Logico-Philosophicus" was influential chiefly amongst the logical positivists, but it has stimulated many other philosophers. Fact|date=October 2007. Main theses. Wittgenstein concluded that with the "Tractatus" he had resolved all philosophical problems, and upon its publication he retired to become a schoolteacher in Austria. The Tractatus Logico-Philosophicus (widely abbreviated and cited as TLP) (Latin for Logical Philosophical Treatise or Treatise on Logic and Philosophy) is the only book-length philosophical work by the Austrian philosopher Ludwig Wittgenstein that was published during his lifetime.
