Eras of rapid economic transformation normally coincide with eras of political crisis, in which political systems are virtually re-founded and then stabilize for a few more generations. And a society's level of economic development can affect matters like urbanization, the popularity of various issues, the relative power of various special-interest groups, et cetera. And politics affects economics. The most obvious are the power of taxation and the issuance of currency. But most states (and all modern ones) also regulate exchanges among private parties within the realm. So we have taxation, currency, and regulation as the basic political aspects of economic life. But there is a deeper way in which economic activities are political.
