The ancient Egyptian goddess of joy, feminine love, and motherhood; Hathor (meaning "Domain of Horus") was closely associated (or was the successor) to Mehet-Weret, the primeval divine cow entity/goddess who was perceived as being responsible for bringing the floods to the Nile, thus in the process fertilizing the land. Continuing with this possibly pre-dynastic concept, Hathor was also regarded as the mother of the sun god Ra. One of the Egyptian gods who formed the triad of Memphis (along with his spouse Sekhmet and daughter Nefertum), Ptah was the personification of creation. Some of the mythical narratives from ancient Egypt pertain to how Nut (as the Sky) mates with her husband (the Earth) to give birth to a host of powerful Egyptian gods like Osiris, Isis, and Set. The scarab was an important symbol in ancient Egypt and one of the gods, Khepri, was shown with the head of a scarab beetle.
