It is generally acknowledged that young people from poorer socio-economic backgrounds tend to do less well in school. The term early childhood intervention (ECI) encompasses both early intervention and preschool special education (Odom & Wolery, 2003). The division of ECI into early intervention (birth to age 3) and preschool special education (ages 3-5) is unique to the United States, whereas ECI in most other countries covers intervention from birth to age 6 and in some cases birth to age 8 (e.g., Odom, Hanson, Blackman, & Kaul, 2003; Soriano, 2005). The use of the scales in research and practice permitted analyses and evaluations of a family-centered approach to working with parents and their children.
