Answer: Dietrich Bonhoeffer (1906-1945) was a Lutheran pastor and theologian living in Germany during World War II. He was one of the organizers of the Confessing Church in Germany, along with Karl Barth and others who actively opposed the regime of Adolf Hitler and the Nazi oppression of the Jews. As a teacher, Dietrich Bonhoeffer balanced a mix of theological rigor and compassion for his fellow man, especially the oppressed. His time in America gave him a new perspective on civil rights issues. His life as a Christian was challenged deeply by one of the most frightening anti-Christ regimes in history, but he remained faithful to the end.
