Verne's first novel, Paris au XXiÙme siècle (Paris in the Twentieth Century)â€ïwritten in 1863 but not published until 1994â€ïis set in the distant 1960s and contains some of his most accurate prognostications: elevated trains, automobiles, facsimile machines, and computer-like banking machines. Nevertheless, the book's depiction of a dark and bitter dystopian world without art was too radical for Jules Hetzel, Verne's publisher.
