Pop art emerged in reaction to consumerism and combined popular culture and contemporary materials to create fun and modern works of art. Pop art is a movement that emerged in the mid-20th century in which artists incorporated commonplace objects—comic strips, soup cans, newspapers, and more—into their work.
