By 1900, San Francisco had also joined with other major American cities in developing a progressive social reform movement and in the first decade of the twentieth century it distinguished itself with a strong Workingman's political party that briefly dominated city politics. The utter devastation of the 1906 earthquake and fire interrupted the path of San Francisco's social, political, and economic evolution, leaving in its wake a scramble for reconstruction. Following the 1906 disaster, progressive reformers saw a golden opportunity in the "great purification by fire" of San Francisco's vice and prostitution districts as well as residential working class neighborhoods [13] Charities and the Commons 16 (2 June 1906) 285.
