He has three children, Imogen, Guiderius and Arivaragus. The two boys have been missing for a long time and appear in disguise as Polydore and Cadwal. Cymbeline themes: The play is very strongly about the concept of truth triumphing over falsehood, good over evil, exemplified in the life of the heroine, Imogen. The absence of the customary author's dedication or benediction - and other evidence associated with the poems - suggest, however, that Shakespeare was not a party to the publication process. First performed in 1609. Cymbeline was written from 1609 to 1610. However, it was first performed in 1623. The themes of Shakespeare's Sonnets include the shortness of life and fleetingness of beauty, ways to achieve immortality (through having children and writing or being written about in poetry), desire and longing, love as a sickness, and poetic patronage. He is quite radical in his love poetry, often departing from courtly ideals of truth and purity to wrangle with sex, lies and love triangles. It is not known whether the Sonnets are autobiographical or purely fictional. The sonnet form and the themes and rhetoric of romantic poetry occur frequently in Romeo and Juliet, most famously at Romeo and Juliet's first kiss. Incorporated into a piece of theatre, each of these enacted sonnets creates a sense of an elevated moment.
