The book went through two to three stages, or "editions", before reaching its current form, at the latest, around AD 90-110. It is written anonymously, although it identifies an unnamed "disciple whom Jesus loved" as the source of its traditions. The Gospel of John is closely related in style and content to the three Johannine epistles, and most scholars treat the four books, along with the Book of Revelation, as a single corpus of Johannine literature.
