It opens up questions concerning the intersection of God, evil, suffering, and how humans relate to them. The Book of Job shows Christians how to speak of God in the midst of suffering.Â  Job â€œlooks for a correct way of talking about God within the most strained and knotty of all human situations: the suffering of the innocent.â€ In this way, Job for this liberation theologian, is a call to take the risk of seeking to understand God in the midst of suffering. We see this shift in Job 42:1-8, where Job realizes the great presence of God that transcends Jobâ€™s previously limited understanding of the Divine. God originally allowed Job's sufferings to commence in order to show Satan and the armies of heaven that Job cherished the worth of God more than his possessions and his family and his health. But after Job showed that he did in fact love God more than all else in the world, there was another purpose that God sought to achieve by letting his suffering drag on for several months. Remember the words of the Lord: Better to suffer the excruciating pain of a gouged out eye than to let any sin remain in your heart. If this does not seem obvious to you—namely, that sanctification is worth any pain on this earth—it is probably because you don't abhor sin and prize holiness the way God does and the way you should. Let us examine ourselves carefully at this point.
